



Shivani also mentioned that they had already given a meaningful start to the new year by pledging help to a 5-year old girl, Shehnaz, who has a 10 mm. hole in her heart & requires an immediate surgery, entailing Rs. 1.50 lakhs. Her mother is a divorcee & is unable to bear these medical expenses. What a noble cause of gifting a life, Rtr. Shivani!

The ZRR, in his address, complimented the outgoing Rotaract team for the good work done by them. He urged Rotaractors to channelise their energies in such a way that Rotaract does not only remain as an experience with them but becomes a habit over time. He motivated Rotaractors to pursue, persevere & perform and requested the Rotarians to actively involve them in their projects & activities.



26 Handicapped Persons Employed in Tata Sons Subsidiary at Mohali

Few months ago, officials of E2E Serwiz Solutions Ltd., Mohali, a subsidiary of Tata Sons Ltd., contacted our President Dr.V.J.S. Vohra for employment of handicapped persons in their call centre. Dr. Vohra, as Prosthetic Consultant and CMD of Nevedac Prosthetic Centre, Zirakpur coordinated the interview of the handicapped persons in the age group of 18 to 35 years, 10+2 pass having basic Computer and English knowledge. After the interview 26 handicapped candidates, having polio deformity of lower limbs and armed with artificial limbs were finally selected. They were given training at Serwiz Solutions, Mohali and finally they have been given regular employment at a monthly salary Rs. 6,000/- plus perks.

On Aug 1, 2006 as per the requirement of the company, Dr. Vohra visited Serwiz Solutions, Mohali and gave the fitness certificates to the employed handicapped persons. DGE Rtn. Shaju Peter, PP Rtn. Capt M.S. Kahlon, IPP Rtn. R.K. Goyal, Secretary R.K. Luther and Rtn. Atul Grover accompanied President Dr. Vohra to meet these handicapped persons and motivate them. The Rotarians interacted with these handicapped employees and it was heartening to see the confidence and

delight of these physically challenged persons. Their company managers were very satisfied with their performance and dedication.

President Dr.Vohra has a database of eligible handicapped persons and it has been felt that we should contact the CEOs and proprietors of other companies so that handicapped persons can get fruitful employment. This project will go a long way to help these "differently-abled" persons to lead their life with pride and dignity to support themselves and their families.

As Rotarians we would make serious efforts to encourage corporate policy of equal opportunities so that the physically challenged persons can be employed at call centres, as receptionists, computer operators, clerks and even for technical jobs. President Dr.Vohra, who has been working for the handicapped persons for the last 33 years, strongly feels that if given the right opportunity, these 'specially abled persons' perform better than normal persons and are more sincere in their duties. Let us help such persons to get jobs and bring laughter in their lives!


