Rtn. Savita Madan started her presentation by paying her respects to Ganesh ji, displaying an impressive painting which she made herself. She thanked PP Deepak Sood for introducing her. She also thanked AG Rtn. Dr. Rita Kalra and President Sanjay for inviting her to the meeting.

Very humbly Rtn. Savita stated that she is not an expert but a student in her field and would continue to be so. She made it clear that she would like to have an interactive session. She said our signatures speak about us and tells about our personality.

She said 12 percent of our thought process is controlled by brain and 88 percent is governed by our subconscious mind, which gives command to our brain, which gives command to the arm and finally to hand which generates on the paper a few curves, loops and straight lines which forms our signature.

She discussed about some of her clients where their signatures played a major role in their life and how their problems could be resolved with minor changes in their signatures. Through simple charts she explained the vertical and slanting signatures and discussed various personalities which can be evident from the signatures. She said the signature talks about our weaknesses, strengths, behaviours and patterns. If the signature of a person can be designed, it overcomes the flaws and then the physical, financial or any problem can be rectified without spending money, and without taking medicine, but only through signature!

She also discussed various signatures which were displayed on the screen. We can change our personality and life by making slight changes in our signature. It is clear from Savita's scientific, lively and convincing explanation through an interesting presentation that the way we sign, plays a very significant role in our life.


