## The talk by Mr. Simar

"Mr. Simar Onkar spoke on the topic: "How psychology can empower you to lead a better life?" He enumerated the steps as; General Interview, Structural interview, Psychology test, Devise and implement, "The intervention strategy program" and follow up at required intervals.
