Living in a Risk Society



Dr. Sherry Sabharwal talks about Risk everywhere

Dr. Balram Gupta as former Chairperson of Department of Sociology, Panjab University. She is author of number of books.

Dr. Sabharwal clarified that Risk Society is a technical term from a Sociologist's point of view. She said, "When we talk of modern society, we talk of medical, infrastructural and technological advancements and in spite of all this we are facing more and more risks every day." She added, "On one hand we have a list of our accomplishments to make our lives better and on the other hand we are facing new risks."

Risk Society is nothing but our own perception. Different people view the risk as per their understanding. Dr. Sabharwal gave the views of two renowned sociologists. One is Ulrich Beck, a German sociologist who holds a professorship at Munich University and at the London School of Economics.

The other person is Anthony Giddens, a British sociologist, who is considered to be one of the most

prominent modern contributors in the field of sociology. According to Giddens, a risk society is a society increasingly preoccupied with the future and also with safety, which generates the notion of risk. The German sociologist Ulrich Beck defines it as a systematic way of dealing with hazards & insecurities induced by modernisation itself.

Modern societies, however, are exposed to risks such as pollution, newly discovered illnesses, crime, that are the result of the modernization process itself. Giddens defines these two types of risks as external risks and manufactured risks. Giddens's concept of a risk society is very positive. There is no question of merely taking a negative attitude towards risk, which needs to be disciplined, but active risk taking is a core element of a dynamic economic and an innovative society.

Dr. Sabharwal concluded that we are better at facing the risks, with an attitude of what ever has to happen will happen, or as we say in Punjabi, "Ki farak penda hai." The talk generated an interesting interactive discussion with the Rotarians. Formal vote of thanks was proposed by Rtn. Atul Grover who thanked Dr. Sabharwal for making the subject so interesting and thought provoking.

The meeting on April 09, 2010 was presided by Vice President Rtn. Arjan Singh in the absence of President Gurdip S. Deep. So, the risk is everywhere, on the field and even in the VIP balconies! The Mumbai Indians took the risk of playing the last match at Mohali, and to the delight of us all, Kings XI Punjab beat them in an exciting IPL T20!
