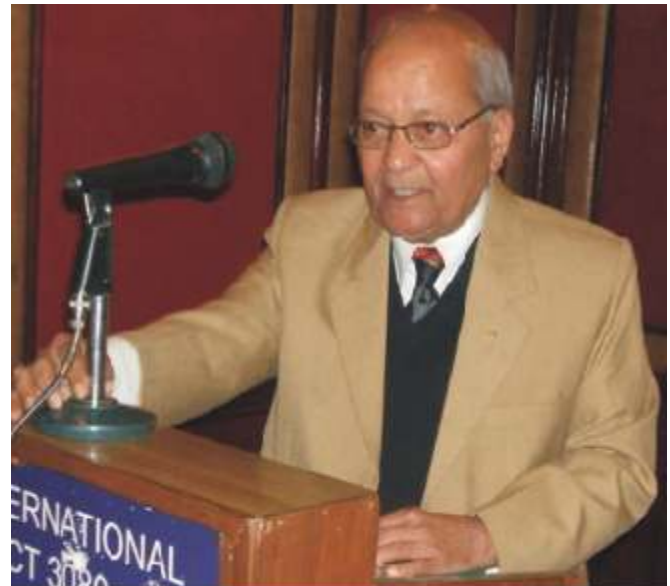


Club Election Ritu is President 2012-13

The Committee met at the District Headquarters on December 17, 2010 to elect the Representative from among eight past district governors who had volunteered to serve in the Council. PDG Ranjit Bhatia has been elected as the alternate representative just in case PDG Shaju would not be

able to travel.

Every three years, each district sends a representative to the Council, which reviews proposed legislation. Each club and district is entitled to submit legislation to the Council, and some of Rotary's most important work has resulted from Council action. Women were admitted into Rotary because of the action of the 1989 Council on Legislation, and PolioPlus was born as the result of the 1986 Council.

The deadline to submit legislation to the 2013 Council on Legislation is December 31, 2011.
