

a women. Some states have women chief ministers and some very key positions in India and other countries are held by women. However, it is the rural women who need to be liberated.


There was a suggestion which surprised and humored everyone, that men, who struggle all their life under immense stress to bring up the family, do not get due recognition, and they need to be liberated too!

The "End Polio Now" Road show is travelling every nook and corner of the country, and meeting officials connected with the Govt. of India's Polio Eradication Program. The Campaign team will also visit the President and Prime Minister to make them aware of the commitment of Rotary International to "End Polio". The Road show will cover approx.18500 kms, covering, two neighbouring countries, Nepal and Bhutan and 24 States of India, educating the public at large especially the weaker sections of society on the importance and the necessity of taking polio vaccine.

The team arrived in Chandigarh on 7th January, and left for Ambala on 9th January 2012 and will be visiting other cities in our District. They are expected to campaign for "End Polio Now" in more than 60 prominent cities, 3000 small towns and villages.
