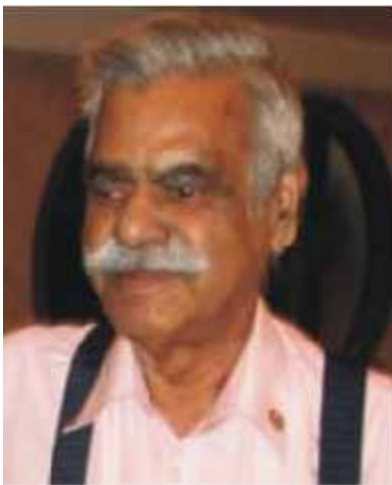

President R.K. Luther said Suraj Handa never wanted to share his problems with others. But he spread happiness and would always say, 'shukar hai', when ever any one enquired about his health. He would forget his ailment and would try to resolve the problem of others. The message that one gets from Suraj's positive attitude is that if you want to overcome your problems, help others in solving theirs!

Requiem to a Rotarian By PP Rtn. Pallav Mukherjee

His heart (made of gold actually) finally gave up – albeit gradually, almost trying to will itself to go on, hold on for a few days more, a few hours more! His blood – with more Rotary cells in it than red blood corpuscles, and the white ones to fight disease, finally failed to reach various muscles and other vital organs of his body, letting them go limp.

And thus came to an end the journey of the thousands of miles that the blood and the body of this Rotarian had

travelled. For over eighty years now, this one man army has been in the battlefield – taking on everything single-handed! Or as some would say – he was almost singularly adamant! In my book – that's a positive.

These and other thoughts kept coming to my mind as Jogi and I followed the hearse on Suraj's last journey from his sector 18 home to the Post Graduate Medical Research Institute in the late hours of Sunday just past midnight. Even

on his last journey he had his way – to the research labs instead of the Crematorium in Sec 25.

From being there more than half a century ago when the villagers tied up to a tree the Chief Administrator (Mr. P.N. Thapar) of the yet to be built city for trying to ask them to sell off their lands to the Govt. to establish the city of Chandigarh, to faithfully recording all the happenings in those heady days when India had just gotten over its throes of Independence, and a painful partition, he was right here in the heart of the city as one of the oldest – as one of the few pioneer photographers, when they were a rarity! As were Hasselblads, Rolleiflexes, and Agfas.

Most people would have a family portrait, or even that rare wedding photo (brown sepia those days) and Suraj Handa would be almost part of that family – turned out in their Sunday best on the grassy lawns.

Coming to what would be Chandigarh, he initially shackled up with a clutch of Architects (in the nucleus of the village of Bajwara) – also pioneers, who were here in town and I've known some of them. Great men! The stories he told me were revelations of those times – when the city was more of green fields and sandy hillocks! There was more village than town in Chandigarh those days!

Somewhere along the line, Suraj accosted a lone leper – discarded by his family and thrown into the trash! It might sound funny, especially in those times, but Suraj picked him up, took him home, got him washed, cleaned, bathed, fed – and the next thing you knew was that there was an IDEA in his head. Which later earned him the highest Rotary Award – “Service Above Self” by the then RI President.

The Leper colony below the Industrial Area II – a desolate area those days – saw the germination of what turned to be one of the winning projects of our club! Oh, one forgot to mention that Suraj, along with a few stalwarts still in our club – were the charter members of the Rotary Club of Chandigarh Midtown in 1977. The Charter President – Dr. B.D. Gupta, still visits our club.

He was also the secretary or president of the All India Photographers Assn. – and was known as one of the tough ones. This toughness was a trait acquired in the RSS shakas – which he joined at the tender age of 14 – in the year 1931. He graduated from the Prince of Wales College much later – in 1946. The partitioning of the country saw him jump right into the middle – and he and his team were instrumental in escorting (he was a macho, mustachioed tough redneck those days) hundreds of Hindu and Sikh families from Sialkot back to camps in Jammu. Remember, there was a program of sorts going on – and the famous book by Khushwant Singh – Train to Pakistan, delineated that.

Suraj was hired by the Indian Army to photograph their battles – in the Dera Baba Nanak and Rajouri sectors. I guess he had an affinity for tanks and guns. This was both in 1965 and 1971.

We don't know how he found the time to get married to Kanta, in 1957.

The list of memories most of us have of him would fill several books – and memories are all that we have left of him today!

God bless his soul – and that we try and look for that star in the heavens that will be him!
