## A vision for Panjab University

On January 4, 2013, presiding over the first meeting of 2013, Vice President Rtn. Amarjit Singh wished all Rotarians and their families a very happy new year. He welcomed the Chief Guest Prof. Dr. Arun Grover, Vice Chancellor, Panjab University, Chandigarh. He also acknowledged the presence of PDG Yoginder Diwan of Rotary Club Parwanoo.

Rtn. Prof. Dr. I.S. Dua, Professor and former Chairman, Department of Botany at Panjab University, introduced Prof. Dr. Arun Kumar Grover, who took over on 23rd July 2012 as the 12th Vice Chancellor of Panjab University, Chandigarh. Dr. Dua also welcomed his wife Dr. Neera Grover, Professor in the Department of Music in PU. Dr. Arun Grover had done B.Sc. Hons. School (Physics) in 1971, M.Sc. Hons. School (Physics) in 1972 from Panjab University, Chandigarh and Ph.D from University of Bombay in 1979. He had held various other important assignments, including his previous one as Senior Professor with the School of Natural Sciences at the prestigious Tata Institute of Fundamental Research (TIFR), Mumbai. From a student, teacher to Vice Chancellor of Panjab University, surely must be a nostalgic journey back home for Prof. Dr. Arun Grover. He has also been recognized with large number of awards. He has over 150 publications to his credit.

Panjab University is one of the oldest Universities in India, established in 1882 at Lahore, now in Pakistan. The university campus is spread over an area of 550 acres in Sectors 14 and 25, Chandigarh.

Before joining as Vice Chancellor, Prof. Arun Grover had 'A

vision for Panjab University'. He had said, "Let me come and join the university first, but my vision will be positive and upward. It will be my responsibility to give the faculty and students a good administration and maintain high reputation of the Panjab University, which is one of the reputed universities of the country and is a primary research institute as well. I will put in all efforts to make it the best university in the field of research in the world."

Elaborating on his vision, Dr. Grover said, "I would like to strengthen the usual USPs of Panjab University, and attempt to add to it the features which will sustain its competitiveness nationally, as well as allow it to compete internationally." One of the USPs of the Panjab University since its positioning at its present location is the Honours School System, where the students can enroll at an impressionable age immediately after leaving the school and be taught by the teachers who are active as researchers as well.

The newly created Indian Institutes of Science Education and

Research in different parts of India have essentially adopted the Honours School system of Panjab University, and added to it the facilities and new features so as to compete with the curricula and brand name of IITs in India and emulate the best contemporary practices of science teaching internationally. Dr. Grover said, "At Panjab University, we need to upgrade ourselves in all aspects so that we can sustain our competitiveness in the disciplines of science and research that get practiced at our campus."

Prof. Grover feels that along with the high quality research activities, there is a need to work towards the enhancement of the undergraduate courses in the University. His endeavour would be to ensure that every year PU becomes the first choice for class XII pass-outs not only from the city but also from neighbouring states like Panjab, Haryana and Himachal Pradesh. His vision is to introduce five-year integrated courses, like MA-Ph.D and MSc-Ph.D.

Prof. Grover called for higher education institutions collaboration with the private sector in research, faculty development, infrastructure creation, student scholarships and

governance. To achieve this, the higher education system should attract corporate investments. He said Punjab University has an annual budget of Rs. 350 crore funded by Central Government, and expressed his desire of 10 percent of it as corporate participation, that is, Rs. 35 crore. He explained, "This can bring in many new changes in the university so that students are trained in a better infrastructure and we attract students from all over India."

There was a knowledgeable inter active discussion between the Vice Chancellor and Rotarians. Formal vote of thanks was proposed by PP Rtn. Prof. Dr. S.K. Sharma, Professor Emeritus, Energy Research Centre and former Dean University Instructions of Panjab University. He thanked Vice Chancellor Prof. Dr. Arun Grover for sharing his positive vision for Panjab University, and expects a great future for this University.

The meeting was followed by cocktails to celebrate the New Year, sponsored by PP Rtn. Gurdip S. Deep, VP Rtn. Amarjit Singh, Secretary Rtn. A.K. Puri and Rtn. Dr. Mrs. Rita Kalra.
