Council on Legislation

In our meeting on May 10, 2013 PDG Shaju Peter gave a report regarding Council on Legislation (COL), which was held in Chicago, USA from April 21 to April 26, 2013.

Rotarians of Chandigarh Midtown were eagerly looking forward to the return of PDG Shaju from Chicago, where he had the honor of representing our District 3080 at the COL. He shared with us an incredible experience of being with 528 fellow Rotarians serving as delegates for their districts. Shaju, a dedicated and a knowledgeable Rotarian, explained to us in his own unique and excellent style the purpose and usefulness of the Council on Legislation, which meets once in three years.

Shaju said, "I am extremely grateful to my club and District 3080 for choosing me as their Representative to COL." He said out of 532 Rotary Districts worldwide only four could not make it. He also gave brief view of Chicago, known for towering skyscrapers, world-class dining, attractive sightseeing, entertainment, hotels, and most-visited city in the Midwest.

COL is also a great opportunity to experience fellowship with Rotarians from all over the world. Shaju said Rotarian John Germ did a great job serving as the Chair of the Council.

The delegates spent a week away from their families and jobs to work together to make Rotary a better organization, strong and vibrant, allowing Rotarians throughout the world to work together to achieve Peace Through Service.

Shaju was also very pleased to meet Past RI Director Mrs. Carolyn Jones who was the RI Representative to our District Conference on 23-24 February 2008, when he was the District Governor. Carolyn is one of the very few lady RI Directors and the First Lady Trustee of the Foundation. She served as a member of the RI constitution and bylaws committee in this council.

Shaju said there were 199 pieces of legislations from all parts of world, out of which two were from District 3080, one from our club and one from Mussoorie. From India there were 28

legislations from 32 Districts.

Shaju said all 528 delegates were put up in Marriott hotel, where COL was held. He said there were also non-voting delegates comprising of past and present RI Presidents, RI Directors and Trustees. But these persons could speak and put before the voting delegates their point of view, which could change the voting pattern. Their experience did carry weight to enable the delegates to decide whether they should accept or oppose the proposed legislation.



Some of the Legislations passed in COL, highlighted by Shaju, are shown below:-

1. Semi Annual Report to all members of club.
2. Former members not to pay admission fees when they re-join a Rotary Club.
3. Engagement in club projects to be connected as attending weekly meetings.
4. Leave for medical reasons can exceed 12 months.
5. 85 rules eliminates age limit of 65.
6. District Governor's spouse, if a Rotarian, exempted from attendance.
7. Satellite clubs permitted.
8. Housewives can become Rotarians.
9. 2/3rd of board members 'present and voting' can terminate a member.
10. Letter of recommendation from former club is required for joining another Rotary Club.
11. No dues certificate within 30 days.
12. Honorary members can wear pin.
13. No restriction of two e-clubs in a District. There can be any number of e-Clubs.
14. 5th avenue of service New Generations re-named as Youth Service.

15. DGNN will be known as DGN Designate (DGND).
16. Every Rotary District will have a PDG as Vice Governor, who takes over if District Governor vacates office.
17. Anyone can opt for Rotarian magazine on the internet.
18. Travel policy of general officers of RI off from RI Bylaws.
19. RI dues increased by one dollar.
20. No minimum semi annual dues.

Amongst the Legislation rejected in the COL were weekly to fortnightly club meetings and permanent RI Theme.

Vote of thanks was proposed by PP B.L. Ramsisaria, who described Shaju's presentation of the Council of Legislation as, "Brilliant! He has explained the procedures and every formality, including the modern technology used, and explained the details about the COL in his inimitable style." BLR added, "Shaju, thank very much. Our club and our District are very much proud of you."

RI President's Monthly message for May 2013

Dear fellow Rotarians,

From the moment I was nominated as Rotary International president, I knew I would choose a theme that would focus on peace. This is why I planned three peace forums – to give Rotarians an opportunity to think about peace, to talk about peace, and to share their ideas on building peace together. The final Rotary Global Peace Forum takes place this month in Hiroshima, Japan.

We hear the word peace every day. But most of us spend little time thinking about what peace is. On its simplest level, we can define peace by what it is not. It is a state of no war, no violence, and no fear. It means that you are not in danger of hunger, or persecution, or the suffering of poverty.

But we can also define peace by what it is, and by what it can be. Peace can mean freedom of thought and of speech, freedom of opinion and of choice, and the ability for self-determination. It can mean security, confidence in the future – a life and home in a stable society. On a more abstract level, peace can mean a sense of happiness, of inner serenity, of calm.

However we use the word, however we understand peace, Rotary can help us to achieve it. Rotary helps us to meet the basic needs of others – to provide health care, sanitation, food, and education when and where they are most needed. It helps to meet the inner needs as well, for friendship, connection, and caring. And Rotary helps us to build peace in its most traditional sense, by reducing the causes of conflict. It builds bridges of friendship and tolerance among people and nations. It helps us to understand one another.

However we define peace, whatever peace means to us, we can bring it closer through service. Peace, in all of the ways that we can
