He has held various district assignments notable being as District Chairman Polio Plus, as Member T.R.F., Assistant Governor Zone 10 in the year 2003-2004, District Chairman Vocational Services, International Committee, Club Services, and Member District Training Team etc. He graduated from District 3080 Leadership Academy in the year 2005 and also attended an Advance Course at Leadership Academy at Chandigarh in the year 2008.

He has travelled abroad and has attended Rotary Club Meeting in U.K. Europe, Bangkok and Shanghai in China. Rotary runs in his family. He father Late Mr. H.C. Gupta was President of Rotary Club Rishikesh. His mother was also member of Inner Wheel Club Rishikesh. His Uncle, Mr. Jagdish Chander Aggarwal is Past President of R.C. Hardwar and Aunty is a Past President of Inner Wheel Club, Haridwar.

He is associated with a number of social and educational committees such as District Eye Relief Society, Dehradun; Vice President State Council of Confederation of India Industries, Dehradun Chapter; 'Himjyoti Foundation' for Education of the poor girls of Garhwal and Trustee of Doon Rotary Charitable Trust of Rotary Club, Dehradun.

He is happily married to Neelima Aggarwal who is a Post Graduate in Social Works from Delhi University and is a Past President of Inner Wheel Club, Dehra Dun. She has won many awards during her leadership. He has a daughter Sarika, an I.T. Engineer married to Vikas Aggarwal, Engineer & M.B.A. from IIM, Lucknow. 
Condolences






