Osteoporosis or Porous Bones

In regular meeting of our club on August 09, 2013 President Deepak Sood acknowledged the presence of Mr. Amit Gulati, Regional Manager of Otto Bock Healthcare India, Chandigarh, global leaders in artificial limbs, of which PP Dr. V.J.S. Vohra is the Consultant. He also welcomed Bobby, son of Rtn. Mrs. Deepa Bhar and her family.

Chief Guest Prof. Dr. Raj Bahadur, Head of Dept. of Orthopaedics in PGI, Chandigarh, was introduced by PP Rtn. Dr. V.J.S. Vohra. As Director-Principal of Govt. Medical College and Hospital, Sector 32, Chandigarh, Dr. Raj Bahadur was very closely associated with Rotary, particularly Rotary Club Chandigarh Midtown. He has also been Hon. Rotarian of our club. He was presented PHF by then RI President Ray Klinginsmith during his visit to Chandigarh in March 2011, and was also honoured by PRIP Raja Saboo, for his sincere efforts to help the cause of Rotary. Our prestigious project - Aasra Shelter in GMCH-32 would not have been possible without the tremendous help and support given by Dr. Raj Bahadur, and this project is now functional since 30th June 2009, when it was inaugurated by then Governor of Punjab and Administrator Chandigarh, General S.F. Rodrigues. Dr. Raj Bahadur is also Director of Regional Spinal Injury Centre in Mohali. He did his MBBS from Medical College Shimla, MS in Orthopaedics from Banaras Hindu University, FICA from USA, MAMS, FAMS from National Academy of Medical Sciences, FIMSA from International Medical Academy and FRCS from Royal College of Surgeons and Physicians of Glasgow (UK). Dr. Raj Bahadur's field of specialization is general orthopaedic surgery, spinal surgery and joint replacement. He has worked in various capacity in HP Medical College and Snowdon Hospital Shimla, Institute of Medical Sciences at BHU Varanasi, Medical College and Hospital Rohtak, PGI Chandigarh, Medical Education and Research Pondicherry, Maulana Azad Medical College and LN Hospital, New Delhi. He is Chairman and Member of numerous Advisory Committees at State, National and International level including Nodal Officer for WHO sponsored health programmes. His work has been widely acclaimed for which he has received many awards, including Punjab Rattan. Dr. Raj Bahadur is a great social activist, and is associated with the disability sector, and he has made meaningful contribution towards the empowerment of disabled persons.

In his impressive presentation Dr. Raj Bahadur explained that osteoporosis or porous bone means deterioration of bone tissue, resulting in weakness of the bone with high risk of fractures in the hip, spine, and wrist. Osteoporosis is a silent disease because

bone loss occurs without symptoms, and you may not know about it until your bones become so weak that a sudden strain, bump, or fall may cause a hip to fracture or a vertebra to collapse, which is felt as severe back pain, loss of height, or spinal deformities.

He said though women are more prone to osteoporosis, but men are also not free from this disease, which needs proper treatment, and he also pointed out certain myths about this ailment to make us aware about the facts which leads to osteoporosis. So the husband should take due care of his wife, keeping in mind that he too is a candidate for this disease!

Dr. Raj Bahadur advised that osteoporosis should not be taken lightly. He also made a comparative study under Indian conditions and USA, where millions of people are having osteoporosis or are at high risk of weak bones and fractures.

There is maximum bone density and strength till the age of 30. After this the risk of osteoporosis increases with the growing age. For ladies, the risk is more. Osteoporosis affects women but men may also develop osteoporosis. The older you get, the greater is risk of osteoporosis as bones weakens with age.

Eating disorder increases your risk for osteoporosis. A diet low in calcium and vitamin D leads to bone loss. Dr. Raj Bahadur highlighted use of certain medications, which can lead to osteoporosis and make you prone to fractures, and therefore you need consultation with your doctor. An inactive lifestyle also weaken the bones. Smoking is harmful for bones and excessive consumption of alcohol also leads to osteoporosis.

To prevent osteoporosis as you age, you need adequate calcium and Vitamin D also plays an important role to keep the bones healthy. Dr. Raj Bahadur also advised exercises to take care of osteoporosis. He told us how Rtn. B.B. Bahl had fracture due to a fall in the bath room, and had to be admitted in PGI. He therefore suggested that to avoid fracture, our bath rooms should not have smooth or glossy tiles, but rough surfaced material or tiles be used for flooring which should not be slippery, to ensure protection from any fall in the bath room.

Dr. Raj Bahadur made his presentation very interesting, and in lighter vein even referred to a quote by Voltaire, "Doctors are men who prescribe medicines of which they know little, to cure diseases of which they know less, in human beings of whom they know nothing."

We are very lucky that a leading eminent orthopaedic surgeon, Prof. Dr. Raj Bahadur makes himself available to us, whether it is our personal ailment or a Rotary event. We have ample opportunities to interact with him. We can always consult him in PGI or at Spinal Injury Centre in Mohali, with prior appointment.

Rtn. K.R. 'Ravi' Ravindran is selected by the Nominating Committee for being the President of Rotary International in 2015-16. He will become the RI President - Nominee on 1st October 2013, if there are no challenging candidates.

He is a member of the Rotary Club of Colombo, Western Province, Sri Lanka.

Ravindran said it is important for Rotarians to share their stories, especially through social media, so

others can see the impact Rotary has had in their lives. He said it is also important for the organization to speak with a consistent voice. "Our identity must remain simple and be based on our core values. It must be clear and straight forward to both our internal and external audience."

Ravindran holds a degree in commerce and is Founder and CEO of Printcare PLC, a publicly listed company and global leader in the tea packaging industry. Ravindran has served as RI Director, Treasurer of RI and as a Trustee of The Rotary Foundation. He has also served as an International Assembly group discussion leader, District Governor, Council on Legislation representative, and zone Institute Chair. He chaired the Schools Reawakening project, sponsored by Rotary clubs and districts in Sri Lanka, which rebuilt 25 tsunami-devastated schools, benefiting 15,000 children.

As his country's PolioPlus Chair, Ravindran headed a task force with members from the Government, UNICEF and Rotary. He worked closely with UNICEF to negotiate a cease-fire with northern militants during National Immunization Days. He has been awarded The Rotary Foundation's Citation for Meritorious Service and Distinguished Service Award and the Service Award for a Polio-Free World.

Ravindran and his wife, Vanathy, have two children, and are level 4 Major Donors to the Foundation.

Know Your Projects - Gift of Hearing

Rotary Club Chandigarh Midtown is right now in the process of implementing the Gift of Hearing project under which we shall be providing hearing aids to poor children and also funding surgeries in some special cases of those who do not require hearing aids but need corrective surgeries to restore or improve their power of hearing.

Our club had been working on a matching grant project of hearing aids for children since 2012-13 which was approved by the Rotary Foundation during the year of IPP Rtn. Ritu Singal. She said, "Every child in Tricity suffering from hearing disability will not be deprived of a hearing aid for want of money.

Wherever necessary, even surgery will be funded." The project has the Rotary Club of Fayetteville and RI District 6110 in USA as our International Partners. The total outlay of the project is Rs. 13.38 lakh.

In partnership with DPI Schools who provides free speech therapy, we shall be able to reach out to poor children and give them a life changing opportunity.

We have already given 30 hearing aids to children of Govt. Schools of 10 years of age and 15 more students have been examined and identified. This project aims to provide hearing aids to 72 children below 10 years of age and 10 Surgeries.
