

Highlights of District Conference – Panchsheel

The purpose of the District Conference is to provide opportunities for networking, inspirational addresses, and discussions of Rotary-related matters. The event recognizes the service programs, projects, and public relations achievements in the district in order to inspire Rotarians to become more involved in service. The conference also gives Rotarians and clubs a vision of Rotary beyond the club level and provides a memorable fellowship experience. Many Rotarians have said that they were never truly enthusiastic about Rotary until they saw an inspirational presentation at a district conference.



PDG Shaju Peter gives highlights of the conference

In our regular meeting on February 26, 2016 PDG Shaju Peter gave the highlights of District Conference – Panchsheel held on February 20-21, 2016 at Dehradun. He started his talk by discussing the five core values of Rotary, which serve as fundamental components of the Rotary Strategic Plan and determine most of the direction and good intent for the whole of our leadership. The five core values are: Service, Fellowship, Diversity, Integrity and Leadership. All of these core values are reflected in

the Object of Rotary and The Four-Way Test, which we use in our daily lives. They inspire us to foster and support the ideal of service for developing and maintaining integrity in human relations and in all our interactions.

Regarding District Conference PDG Shaju said, “Generally a conference is of two days which also has a pre-conference dinner which is assembly of Rotarians and their families.” For this the registration fee is extra.

Governor of Uttarakhand Dr. K.K. Paul inaugurated the District Conference on February 20, 2016. PDG Shaju remarked, “The inauguration was absolutely spectacular and a vibrant programme.”

PDG Shaju said, “One great thing about this conference was that there was a tremendous content of service projects and celebration of projects by Rotary International President's Representative.” Every district conference has a representative from the RI President because he himself cannot go to 534 conferences all over the world.

Therefore he sends his personal representative to each of the 534 conferences. For our district conference, due to PRIP Raja Saboo, as RI President Ravindran's Representative we had RI President Nominee (2017-18) Ian Riseley from Australia who was accompanied by his wife Juliet. RIPN Riseley is a chartered accountant by profession, a major donor and a Paul Harris Society member.

District Governor David Hilton who is a teacher and runs a school was able to get thousands of school children to participate in this event which created a tremendous atmosphere in the venue.

Shaju was pleased to say, “I was impressed by the revival of Rotaract movement in 3080.” This year we have a dynamic young man as District Rotaract Representative Rtr. Mohit Singla. He added, “Similarly the Interact Chair of the District, our own President Nominee Dr. Rita Kalra made a remarkably effective presentation on Interactors of 3080 which went off extremely well.”

There were eminent speakers to address the Rotarians. Shaju appreciated the 20 minute presentation by Swami Chidananda Saraswati from the Parmarth Niketan. Another impressive speaker was Mrs. Jo Chopra, an American settled in Dehradun after her marriage to a Punjabi. She caters to the needs of the disabled. Her son is a business man and a daughter is doing doctorate. She adopted a mentally challenged child who is now grown up. Another speaker retired Air Marshal Denzil Keeler, PVSM, KC, AVSM, VrC who is Chairman of Special Olympics Bharat inspires disabled people to compete in the para Olympics, an event for the disabled from all over the world.

There was an amazing presentation of reconstruction of schools in Uttarakhand. Out of 35 schools our district has built up 25 each costing about Rs. 12 lakh. All this has been possible due to the devotion of PRID Yash Das and PDG Prem Bhalla. There were presentations on Medical Missions to Mallavi, Ethiopia and Rwanda, and the RI Convention in Seoul.

Second day of the conference had a business session where the issues related to our district were debated and replied to by a panel led by PDG Yoginder Diwan, which was dealt in an amicable manner and with understanding.

Shaju had great praise for the shreyas awards which was instituted in Rotary year 2007-08 when he was the District Governor. The awardees selected for the current conference were exceptionally brilliant people which included the well known Bollywood actor Tom Alter.

The conference culminated with the selection of District Governor Nominee Designate for 2018-19. This time the nominating committee did not have any Past District Governor but only nine Past Presidents as its members who were selected by draw of lots. This was according to the current legislative. The nominating committee interviewed all the candidates and announced the name of PP Jitender Dhingra of Kurukshetra who was selected as the

DGND.

Secretary Sanjay Bhatia thanked PP Harish Sethi for organizing the visit of Rotary Friendship Exchange team. He also thanked PDG Shaju Peter for the detailed account of the District Conference.

Role of mothers in educating their children

The 61st programme of the current Rotary year on literacy for teaching the skills to students was a tailor made attempt based on the need of a typical situation. A special course had to be designed for such mothers to advise and motivate them that they start sending their children to school and then the teachers could provide them proper education. Rtn. Amarjit Singh, and together they designed a powerpoint presentation with videos which they showed to 80 mothers, who were told about e-learning and modern ways of education and how children are exposed to new techniques to meet challenges. 

PDG Shaju Peter speaks at 3202 Conference

PDG Shaju Peter was one of the invited speakers at the District Conference of 3202 held at Muthukrishnan Convention Centre, Tirupur on February 06 and 07, 2016.

Invited by District Governor Dr. George Sundararaj, PDG Shaju dealt with the topic 'Total Literacy in India – a Challenge' in the first plenary session on February 07. The 40 minute session included the formal introduction by PDG V.G. Nayanar and a 35 minute talk by Shaju on Literacy. He dealt with the Global scenario of literacy with particular emphasis on India and the lesson to learn from his home State, Kerala with the highest literacy rate of 94% in India.

District 3202 comprises of 135 clubs in parts of Kerala and Tamil Nadu with over 5000 Rotarians. The Conference had an attendance of over 1000 delegates.
