In order to further help the patient, Director Youth Service Rtn. Sundeep Singh Sawhney coordinated with PGIMER cardiology department and implant companies to facilitate the purchase medicines, implants and disposables at subsidized rates, which were provided on day of surgery to reduce the burden on the poor patient. The surgery was a success and patient has been discharged now.

PE Amarjit Singh and DYS Sundeep S. Sawhney presented the balance amount by cheque to the Rotaractors in presence of Vice Principal, senior staff and Rotaractors.
