Human Rights under the Constitution of India

In our regular meeting on September 02, 2016, after greeting all present, President Rtn. Amarjit Singh said, "September is a Literacy month and we plan to participate in all programs of TEACH, Teacher Support, Elearning, Adult Literacy, Child Development and Happy School."

He welcomed the Chief Guest Prof. Dr. Nishtha Jaswal, Professor and Former Chairperson, Department of

Laws, Panjab University, Chandigarh and Member, Chandigarh Commission for Protection of Child Rights. Prof. Dr. Nishta was introduced by Rtn. Prof. Dr. I.S. Dua, who was pleased to announce that she was one of the brightest students of PP Rtn. Dr. Balram K. Gupta. Her educational qualifications are B.A. (Gold Medalist), B.L., LL.B., LL.M. and Ph.D from Panjab University. She has been getting first division all throughout the academic career: First position in Panjab University in B.A.-II and B.A.-III, first position in College in Pre-University, B.A.-I, B.A.-II and B.A.-III. She has four books to her credit: (i) Role of the Supreme Court with regard to the Right to Life and Personal Liberty (ii) Human Rights and the Law (iii) Environmental Law and (iv) Law as a Facilitator of Socioeconomic Reforms. She has vast administrative and professional experience. Her field of specialisation is Constitutional Law, Administrative Law, Human Rights and Environmental Law. She also served in Panjab University as Dean Students Welfare (Women). Her husband is Professor Dr. Paramjit S. Jaswal, Vice Chancellor of Rajiv Gandhi National University of Law at Patiala who had visited our club as Chief Guest at the installation ceremony of PP Rtn. Deepak Sood on July 22, 2013.

Prof. Nishta spoke about a very important issue, Human Rights under the Constitution of India. The Constitution is the supreme law of our country. The supremacy of the Constitution is undisputed and cannot be challenged in any court of law. She shared the views of Dalai Lama on human rights. All human beings suffer when they are intimidated, imprisoned or tortured. We must therefore insist globally on all human beings getting freedom, equality and dignity, and they all have equal right to achieve that. She quoted Mahatma Gandhi, "Live as if you were to die

tomorrow. Learn as if you were to live forever."

Prof. Nishta said, "Human rights simply means the rights which must be available to human beings. Any civilization can be recognized from the human rights to citizens of that country." She added, "When we talk globally or nationally, the spirit of dignity is necessary." Human right is based on the dignity of human beings. She also explained the six freedoms. Freedom of speech and expression; to assemble peaceably and without arms; to form associations or unions or cooperative societies; to move freely throughout the territory of India; to reside and settle in any part of the territory of India; to practice any profession, or to carry on any occupation, trade or business.

For exercising of power, it was explained that power is always vested under some law and there is a control mechanism which is essential for any administration or government to function.

Prof. Nishta said we have the right to know, that is, Right to Information (RTI Act, 2005) which is one of the most significant

development. Her talk resulted in a vibrant interactive discussion with Rotarians regarding the functioning of the courts in India and the delays which denies justice. The doctors described their plight for being harassed for no fault of theirs, whereas there is no accountability in the judicial system. Many people become victims of serious health hazards due to the agony, delays and injustice that they have to face!
