The Crisis of Collegium System

Mr. Gurminder Singh, Senior Advocate was the chief guest in our regular meeting on September 16, 2016. There was an interesting panel discussion with the chief guest in conversation with PP Rtn. Dr. Balram K. Gupta and PP Rtn. R.T.P.S. Tulsi.

Number of students of PP Dr. Balram Gupta have addressed our club on many earlier occasions. Introducing the chief guest, Dr. Balram Gupta said, "Gurminder is one of those students who I can truly and fully acknowledge. I am proud of him." As a young lawyer he was very articulate and very persuasive in his arguments. Over the years he has matured so well. He was Additional Advocate General for many years, and the way he defended the Govt.,

there are very few who could do that. He is passionate of each matter he argues. Six years back he resigned from the post of Addl. Advocate General to start his private practice. Soon he was designated as senior advocate and got this recognition at a young age.

The other panelist, our own PP Rtn. R.T.P.S. Tulsi did not need any introduction. A popular Rotarian, he is a well known leading lawyer.

Dr. Balram Gupta who anchored the discussion explained the crisis of the collegium system. On September 01, 2016 Justice Jasti Chelameswar of the Supreme Court refused to join the rest of the Collegium, very boldly raising the issue of lack of transparency in

the judiciary. This has led to deep crisis in the Indian judiciary which has its roots in the obsolete and undemocratic process of selection and appointment of judges to the higher courts. Justice Chelameswar has questioned the opaque system of Collegium where only judges select the judges, that too secretly, without any participative or consultation process. Justice Chelameswar's objection against Collegium, declared off the bench, provided an added legitimacy to his dissent expressed while on the bench. A revolt right from within, has a striking relevance, when the concern itself is regarding the obscurity in the process.

Within the legal fraternity it is strongly debated that openness, accountability and transparency alone can ensure better judicial democracy.

Advocating transparency, Mr. Gurminder Singh said, "Selecting a High Court or a Supreme Court judge is a job which carries with it a great sense of responsibility, and there has to be a complete transparency from the outside for the common man."

PP R.T.P.S. Tulsi responded to the transparency issue with reference to the 1993 and the latest 2015 judgments, and the memorandum of procedure (MOP). He said, "There has to be accountability as well as transparency and the proceedings should be in writing. MOP which is in place since 1993 is not being followed." The judiciary wants to have the final say but it is argued that how could a judge be a judge for his own cause. To this Dr. Balram replied, "The political executives are at a liberty to choose their own ministers. If they can do that then what is the objection if judges choose the judges." Gurminder's democratic

response was, "Those appointed as ministers are the ones who have been elected by the general public of India, but in the appointment of judges the public of India has no say at all."

Gurminder also talked about the Right to Information Act as Supreme Court applies it to other government, public and social establishments, then why RTI Act is not made applicable to the Apex court.






Rotaract Club of Vidya Jyoti
